So pleased you are considering joining Pony Club. You, as an adult Horsemaster member, or your child doesn't need a horse to join Pony Club, just a passion and commitment to learn horsemanship; benefit from the skills, habits and values instilled through horsemanship that will apply to every part of our lives. Pony Clubs foster superb equestrians, extraordinary citizens, and lifelong friendships. Your family is invited to meet us and observe a mounted or un-mounted meeting, practice, or regional rally. Please call me so that we may find a time, place, and activity to show what Pony Club can offer your family.

Complete the USPC membership application with original signatures and US mail to 35805 Alder School Road, Round Hill VA 20141 or deliver in person with new member fees payable to CWPC. See the Club Guidelines to familiarize your family with the membership opportunities and responsibilities.

Casanova-Warrenton Pony Club (CWPC) offers a spring and fall mounted lesson series of 6-8 lessons for a fee of \$20 per lesson. Monthly, Club Clinic Days offer a full day of two mounted (\$20 per mounted lesson) and un-mounted lessons. January and February weekly un-mounted ground school sessions, culminating with Quiz Rally, and D-1 certification are included in membership fee.

Pony Club lesson and camp instruction is significantly less expensive than lesson barns or businesses. Camp is Monday thru Thursday, in late June. The cost of camp is discounted for CWPC members and includes 4 days of riding 3xs a day in various disciplines, stabling, bedding, food, pool, equine crafts, mounted and un-mounted instruction. Loaner horses and transportation can always be found if the application and payment is received by mid-April.

Pony Club is a volunteer organization. The family parent or guardian is the adult volunteer sponsor for the member and learns about the responsibilities of horsemanship and along with the member. The adult sponsor or parent volunteers at the Twilight Polo gate, Great Meadow, The Plains, on your choice of Saturday evenings from May to Sept with the member to fulfill fundraising commitment. Each member fulfilling about 6-8 volunteer slots funds the costs of lessons, camp and certifications and, promotes preservation of open spaces for equine sports by supporting Great Meadow Foundation.

Local Pony Clubs function and provide programming through volunteers, club sponsors, hired professional instructors, and the support and permission of USPC, a vital structured national educational organization.

Parents and sponsors attend 2 club business meetings per year. The annual fall sponsor meeting is Saturday, November 4, 2018, 12:00 noon, at the Club Clinic Day. The Annual Kickoff Parent/Sponsor Meeting is Saturday, February 9, 2019, 10:00AM in conjunction with member un-mounted meeting.

Applications are be processed by the national office that will mail a membership pin and access to website. Members in good standing participate in Pony Club activities at the local, regional, or national level when and where appropriate, according to age, experience, and suitability of mount.

New members participate on own pony or on a borrowed mount and are tested to receive club level certificate D-1. Look for email communication for upcoming activities. Don't hesitate to call me with any questions of "What's next?" or "What can we do? "
